University Governance NOONAN ENDOWMENT FUND COMMITTEE

University President

The Noonan Endowment Fund was established to facilitate and encourage programs and events for the enrichment of students at the University. The fund is intended to supplement classroom instruction and broaden the cultural awareness of the entire University community. The committee is charged with the responsibility for implementing the Fund on an annual basis.

Membership

1. One faculty representative from each of the four academic units (Education, Humanities, Social Sciences, Science & Mathematics) and one representative from non-school faculty elected by the Faculty Senate for overlapping terms of two years.
2. One student representative appointed by the Student Senate.
3. Director of Library Services, serving as committee chairperson.

Functions

1. Establishes application periods for funding twice yearly.
 - a. For the fall term, the application period is from the first day of classes through the end of the third week of the term.
 - b. For the spring and summer terms, the application is from the first day of classes through the third week of the term.
2. Consider funding requests at the close of each application period. Applicants are notified of decisions within two weeks thereafter.

Modifications

Modifications of this committee may be made by the University President or his/her designee.
