4. APSCUF-MU president or designee.
5. SCUPA-MU president or designee.
6. AFSCME-MU president or designee.
7. Eight faculty representatives, two each from the three schools and non-school faculty.
8. Two University Advancement representatives.
9. Two Finance and Administration representatives.
10. One Student Affairs representative.
11. One Information Technology representative.

### **Functions**

1. Foster better communication and collaborative/creative thinking on major University issues.
2. Expand the University's leadership team and facilitate deliberation regarding administrative policies and procedures.

### **Modifications**

Modifications to the President's Advisory Leadership Council reside with the Executive Cabinet.
