SELECTION OF INTERIM PRESIDENT or ACTING PRESIDENT

Adopted: June 20, 1983;
Amended December 3, 2008

The procedure for selecting an individual for interim president or acting president is stipulated by the Board of Governors policy 1983-14-A as follows:

When the office of a university president becomes vacant prior to the appointment of a regular successor, the Chancellor shall recommend the name of a candidate for the interim presidency to the Board of Governors after consultation with the university's council of trustees. The council of trustees shall consult with the students, faculty, and alumni before making its recommendation to the Chancellor. The interim president shall serve until the Board of Governors has appointed a permanent president or until the interim president has been relieved of the presidential duties and responsibilities.
