## Membership

- Two faculty representatives from each of the four academic units (Education, Humanities, Social Sciences, Science & Mathematics) elected by Faculty Senate for overlapping twoyear terms, and one representative from non-college faculty elected by Faculty Senate for a two-year term. No faculty member may serve more than two consecutive terms.
  - No two members may be elected from the same department. This limitation shall not apply to the committee chairperson.
- 2. Two student representatives, elected by Student Senate each fall for overlapping twoyear terms.
- 3. The Provost and the Registrar or designee(s), as ex officio non-voting member(s).
- 4. The chairperson is elected by the Faculty Senate, convenes and meets with the committee on a regular basis, attends all Faculty Senate meetings in order to act as a liaison regarding all business pertaining to the committee, and submits an annual written report, outlining the membership and work of the committee.
- 5. The terms of the chair and faculty members begin in September and end in August of the appropriate year.

## **Functions**

- Review all proposed changes in academic policies, regulations, structure and related matters at the undergraduate level and present its recommendations to the Faculty Senate.
- 2. Initiate recommendations in academic policies, regulations, structure and related matters at the undergraduate level and present its recommendations to the Faculty Senate.
