

Millersville University Presents
A LONDON THEATRE TOUR
June 2010 (dates to be determined)

In this unique week long class we will explore theatre as it developed in the exciting city of London, England.

The program will be headquartered in London at Millersville's official partner, the London Metropolitan University and requires daily field trips to nearby locations in the city. Most class gatherings will be on-site, focusing on first-hand experience (as opposed to lecture) and leaving ample time for students to explore London on their own. The course includes attendance at four professional theatre performances in London, as well as backstage tours at the Globe Theatre, the National Theatre and the Royal Theatre Drury Lane.

Students will live in a London Met dormitory with 4 to 6 students per apartment suite. Within each apartment accommodations include single bedrooms, kitchen, bathroom facilities and showers. Dorms are within walking distance of the Underground (TUBE) Train Line.

Enrollment is limited to 15 participants, including university students at all levels, non-degree seeking students and educators seeking Continuing Ed credits.

The cost of the program is \$1750.00 for the week. This cost includes:

- Round Trip air fare (Phila. – London – Phila.)
- London airport transportation (arrival & departure)
- 7 nights accommodations – London Met. Univ. Dorm
- Theatre Tours (Globe Theatre, Royal Theatre Drury Lane, National Theatre)
- Tickets for four live theatre performances including a play at the Globe theatre

The cost does not include Millersville tuition (THREE CREDITS – THEA 217 or 412 or 579), passport, meals or transportation to and from Philadelphia, the city of departure.

The deadline for sign-up for the course is November 15, 2009. A deposit of \$500 is due at that time. The Balance of payment is due by March 1, 2010.
