The Cost of Attendance (COA), also known as the Student Budget, is comprised of both direct costs (those billed directly by the university) and indirect costs (possible costs incurred by a student while attending school, but not billed by the university). This number is used by the school to determine the maximum amount of financial aid a student can receive for that award year.

Please note the costs listed are per YEAR and rates are subject to change. Actual costs for 2018-2019 will not be finalized by the Board of Governors until July 1, 2018 at the earliest.

Costs are also based on full-time enrollment (9 credits for doctoral students). For students living on campus, please note that actual Room and Board charges will vary depending on the student's room assignment and which meal plan is chosen.
