

2018-2019 **ACTUAL** Cost of Attendance (COA)

The Cost of Attendance (COA), also known as the Student Budget, is comprised of both direct costs (*those billed directly by the university*) and indirect costs (*possible costs incurred by a student while attending school, but not billed by the university*). This number is used by the school to determine the maximum amount of financial aid a student can receive for that award year.

Costs are also based on full-time enrollment (9 credits for graduate and teacher certification students).
