

VA ENROLLMENT CERTIFICATION CHANGES

WHAT CHANGES WERE MADE?

Beginning Summer 2018, Enrollment Certification with the VA will no longer be automatic. Students must now request benefits to be certified for each semester they are enrolled and wish to receive benefits.

WHY WERE THESE CHANGES MADE?

In the past, VA enrollment certifications were automatically submitted as long as students were registered. Due to an increase in students using VA education benefits, we will be utilizing a VA Enrollment Certification Form to better serve our student veterans and military families.

- The VA Enrollment Certification Form lets the VA Certifying Officials know you want to be certified for your classes, gives you the opportunity to update your current contact information, and gives Millersville University the permission to release your information to the VA.

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT ME?

Students must now fill out a VA Enrollment Certification Form each semester **after** you register for classes. A separate form must be submitted for each semester you wish to receive benefits.
