Millersville University: British GCE A & AS Levels Credit Awarding Procedure

Millersville University recognizes the value of the rigorous British GCE A & AS Levels Curriculum and considers it seriously when evaluating the credentials of admission applicants. Credit will be awarded on a course-by-course basis for exams taken at the Advanced Level (A-Level) or Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level and graded a US equivalent "C" (e.g. A-E) or above unless indicated otherwise in the equivalency chart.

Credit awarded for British GCE A & AS Levels Examinations may be used to satisfy general education requirements, major or minor requirements, or electives in the same manner as Advanced Placement (AP). Students will not receive duplicate credit for IB examinations, AP examinations, A & AS Levels, or any other college courses taken before or after enrolling at Millersville University.
