**MILLERSVILLE UNIVERSITY CRITERIA FOR
ADMISSION TO ADVANCED PROFESSIONAL STUDIES**

The criteria for Admission to Advanced Professional studies are:

1. The completion of 60 semester hours of credit
2. A Millersville University minimum cumulative quality point average as follows:
 - a. 2.6 qpa if admitted to APS during the 2001-2002 academic year, or
 - b. 2.8 qpa if admitted to APS during the 2002-2003 academic year, or
 - c. 3.0 qpa beginning with the Fall 2003
3. Qualifying scores on the Praxis I Pre-Professional Skills Tests (4 PPST - Reading, Math, & Writing)
4. Recommendation for admission by faculty member teaching professional education courses
5. Satisfactory completion of:

Composition (ENGL 110)

Fundamentals of Speech (COMM 100)
6. Two college-level (6 credits) English courses (ENGL 110 included)
7. Two college-level (6 credits) Mathematics courses
8. Photocopies of satisfactory Act 34 (Criminal Record check) report, satisfactory Act 151 (Child Abuse History clearance) report, and a completed background information sheet on file with the Early Field Experiences office
