

**TIMELY WARNING**  
**CAMPUS ALERT**  
**SEXUAL ASSAULT**

**May 13, 2013 Posting**

This communication is prepared as part of the Timely Warning requirement of the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act of 1990. This federal law requires a general communication to the campus community of all crimes reported to campus or local police departments that may pose a threat to the campus community. Such reports shall be provided to students and employees in a manner that is timely and that may aid in the prevention of similar occurrences.

In the early morning hours of Monday, May 13, 2013 Millersville University Police received a delayed report that a student was sexual assaulted by an acquaintance, who is also a student at Millersville. The student related that the assault occurred at around 1:00 am on Sunday, May 12, 2013 after the student and acquaintance returned from an off-campus party.

The incident is reported to have occurred in the student's room, a residence hall on the south side of campus. The acquaintance student has been identified, and University Police are working with University officials on a timely, coordinated investigation.

Any person who is familiar with this report is asked to call Deputy Chief Howard Bauman at 717-872-3524. Callers can remain anonymous.

Members of the campus community are urged to take normal personal safety precautions such as locking their rooms even when home, walking with a buddy or other known students, walking in well lit and well travelled areas, securing all personal items while walking and reporting all suspicious persons and activity to police. University Counseling and Human Development, Health Services and Peer Health Educators assist students in prevention, response and recovery of intimate partner violence and assaults. The Millersville University Police Department provides a safety escort from 11pm-7am and can be contacted at 717-872-3433. The University and Borough Police are directly dispatched if students call 911 in an emergency.
