

TIMELY WARNING

16 SEPTEMBER 2010

This communication is prepared as part of the Timely Warning requirement of the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act of 1990. This federal law requires a general communication to the campus community of all crimes reported to campus or local police departments that may pose a threat to the campus community. Such reports shall be provided to students and employees in a manner that is timely and that may aid in the prevention of similar occurrences.

Millersville University Police were informed that on Wednesday night, September 15, 2010, Millersville Borough Police were dispatched for a robbery in the 100 block of Lee Avenue, Millersville Borough. A twenty-one year old male victim stated that he was assaulted and robbed of several items. The suspects were described as three to four black males in their 20's. The primary actor was approximately 5'8" in height wearing white gym shorts, a mostly shaved head, and no facial hair. This incident is currently under investigation by the Millersville Borough Police Department.
