

Millersville University of Pennsylvania Crime Rates and Statistics

This report, prepared by the Millersville University Police, is published in compliance with Pennsylvania Act 1988-73, the College and Security Information Act. The crime rate is computed as follows: the number of crimes in each category is divided by the gross number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students and employees. For example, in 2008, the University had 8,113 FTE students, employees, and 28 known burglaries. To calculate the crime rate: 28 burglaries for 8,113 FTE=.00345 burglaries per FTE or 7.4 incidents per 10,000 population.
