

TIMELY WARNING

CAMPUS ALERT

25 June 2007

This communication is prepared as part of the Timely Warning requirement of the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act of 1990. This federal law requires a general communication to the campus community of all crimes reported to campus or local police departments that may pose a threat to the campus community. Such reports shall be provided to students and employees in a manner that is timely and that may aid in the prevention of similar occurrences.

The Millersville Borough Police Department has reported that a sexual assault was reported from an address located on Hillview Avenue, an area adjacent to the University campus. According to information provided by the Borough Police, a 19 year old non-student reported she was the victim of a sex offense during the early morning hours of 25 June 2007. The Borough Police have the identity of the alleged assailant and are progressing with the investigation. Neither the victim nor the alleged perpetrator were noted as Millersville University students.
