CAMPUS ALERT

This communication is required as part of the Timely Warning requirement of the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act of 1990. This law requires a general communication to the campus community of all crimes reported to campus or local police departments that may pose a threat to the campus community. Such reports shall be provided to students and employees in a manner that is timely and that may aid in the prevention of similar occurrences.

This campus alert is directed to the resident students of Millersville University. On 11 February two burglaries were reported in Lenhardt Hall, one on the third, and one on the fifth floor. It was reported that at least one of the rooms was unlocked. In both cases a laptop computer was stolen, and in one incident an iPod and other personal items were taken from the room. The two incidents have an estimated loss value in excess of \$4,000.00.

The purpose of this alert is to remind resident students to do the following:

- Always lock your door, even if only leaving the room for a few minutes. It takes less than a minute to remove a lap top or iPod from a room.
- Report all strangers walking the halls of your living area.
- Do not let "trailers" enter the residence hall behind you.
- Do not leave valuables unattended in public places to include electronic items and textbooks.
