Follow-up to Timely Warning - Important Information

Earlier today we were informed of the tragic death of one of our students, in Shenk's Hall. He died of an apparent self-inflicted gunshot. During the police investigation, there was concern for a potential threat to the campus. Because of this information, the student walkout/rally on the Quad was asked to disperse. Police then spoke to a person of interest who is not affiliated with the University. After that discussion, Millersville Borough Police Chief, John Rochat indicated that the campus is no longer at risk.
