

Statement on Confidentiality of Student Records

Student academic records are confidential. According to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), the academic information you are able to view cannot be released to a third party without the written consent of the student. FERPA definition of “third party” includes parents, roommates, prospective employer, etc. If the word **CONFIDENTIAL** appears on a student record (special confidentiality flag), even directory information – address, phone number, major, dates of attendance, and degrees earned – cannot be released to a third party.

You have been authorized to access student information for the sole purpose of fulfilling your respective professional responsibilities. Your use of the system implies that you understand the FERPA restrictions, and further, you agree to adhere to these regulations.
