

Blackboard 6: Adding an Ordering Question 8 Steps

This Step-by-Step explains the procedures for adding an ordering question in Blackboard 6.

This Step-by-Step assumes that the quiz has already been added and accessed.

1.) From the drop-down menu select “Ordering” and click “Go”

2.) Type in the desired question in the text field labeled, “Question Text”.

- You will also need to enter a point value in the text field labeled, “Point Value”

3.) You will now need to enter the answers in the correct order.

4.) Click “Next”

5.) You will now need to select the order in which you would like the answers to be displayed. Note: the default order is the correct order, so be sure to change them.

- To change the order click on the drop-down menu next to each answer and choose this position by selecting a number.

Answers

Set the display order for the answer items.

Display Order	Correct Order
<input type="button" value="1"/> Click next.	Select Ordering and click go
<input type="button" value="2"/> Enter the answers in the correct order. Type desired question.	Enter the answers in the correct order.
<input type="button" value="3"/> Select Ordering and click go	Click next.
<input type="button" value="4"/> Type desired question.	

6.) You may now enter a correct answer and incorrect answer response feedback.

7.) Click “Submit”
