

Blackboard 6: Adding a Random Block Question 5 Steps

This Step-by-Step explains the procedures for adding a random block question in Blackboard 6.

This Step-by-Step assumes that the quiz has already been added and accessed.

1.) From the drop-down menu select “Random Block” and click “Go”

5.) A receipt will appear showing what you just created, click “OK” and you are done.
