


Blackboard 6: Adding True/False in a Quiz 4 Steps


This Step-by-Step explains the procedures for adding true/false questions to a quiz in Blackboard 6. *Prerequisite:* Quiz has already been added.

1.) After the quiz has been created, the screen should look something like this.



Click the drop down box, select **True/False** and then click **Submit**.


2) There will be a list of information to fill out. First, enter the question into the text box.



You can enter in the point value next for the question.

* **Point Value**

Next, choose whether the question is true or false by selecting the button.



Correct Answer	Answer Values
<input checked="" type="radio"/>	True
<input type="radio"/>	False

Feedback

Enter feedback that will display in response to a correct answer and an incorrect answer.

Correct Response Feedback

Incorrect Response Feedback

Then, enter a response to a correct answer and a response to an incorrect answer in the appropriate text boxes.

3) When finished choose:

Cancel to return to previous page without saving changes you made in current question.



Submit to save question.

To modify any question click on the **Modify** button next to the question

Make desired changes and click submit.



Click **Remove** to remove question from the test permanently.

4.) A receipt will appear showing what you just created, click “OK” and you are done.
