

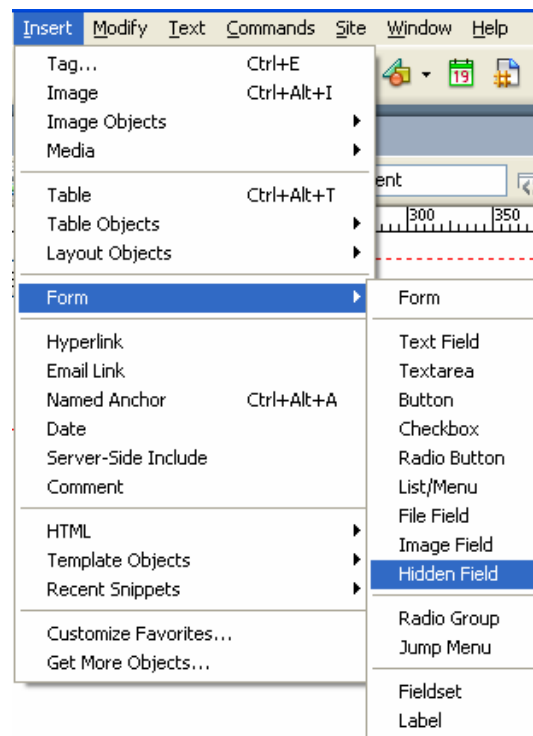
Creating Hidden Fields for Use Inside a Form Using Dreamweaver 8

3 Steps

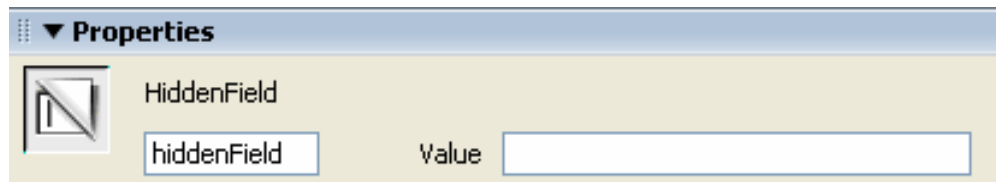
This Step-by-Step explains the procedures for creating a Hidden Field for use in the form inside Macromedia Dreamweaver 8 to be published on a faculty member's website.

This Step-by-Step assumes that the user has already created a form using Macromedia Dreamweaver 8.

- 1) Click inside the red dashed box (the form).
- 2) From the menu bar, choose **Insert > Form > Hidden Field**.
– A Hidden Field icon will appear inside the form.



- 3) In the **Properties** window you will need to specify the value of the hidden field.



- It is also recommended that you name the hidden field for your own reference.
 - When naming the hidden field you may not use spaces or upper case characters in the name. Using these may cause the form not to function properly with some browsers.
