

## Creating Hidden Fields for Use Inside a Form 3 Steps

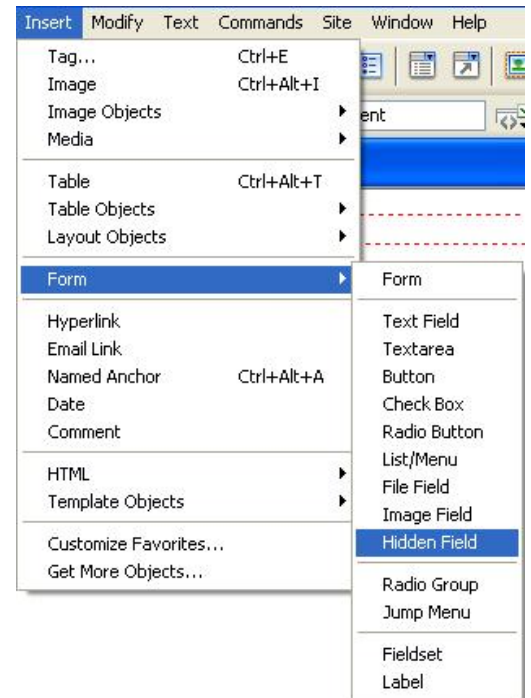
This Step-by-Step explains the procedures for creating a Hidden Field for use in a form inside Macromedia Dreamweaver MX 2004 to be published on a faculty member's website.

This Step-by-Step assumes that the user has already created a form using Macromedia Dreamweaver MX 2004.

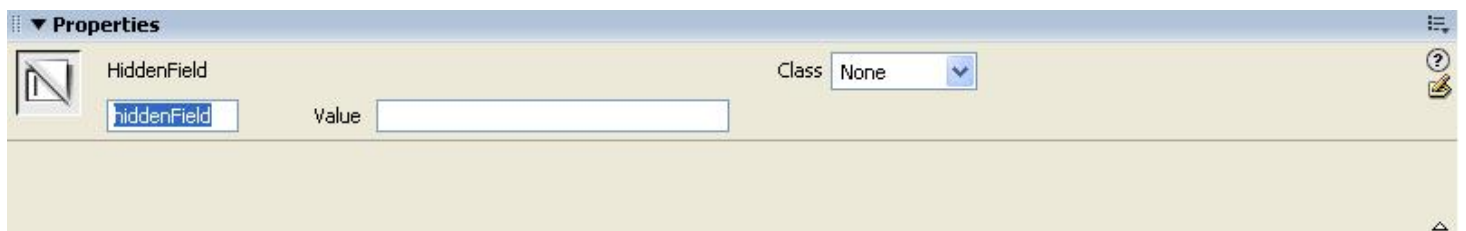
1.) Click inside the red dashed box (the form).

2.) From the drop down menus at the top of the screen choose Insert > Form >Hidden Field.

- A Hidden Field icon will appear inside the form.



3.) In the Properties window you will need to specify the value of the hidden field.



- It is also recommended that you name the hidden field for your own reference.  
- When naming the hidden field you may not use spaces or upper case characters in the name. Using these may cause the form not to function properly with some browsers.
