UNDERGRADUATE CERTIFICATE TELEHEALTH CERTIFICATE

This online, 10-credit undergraduate certificate is open to all majors and guest students! There is a growing demand for telehealth as a modality to improve patient outcomes in professions such as social work, nursing, counseling, pharmacy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, respiratory therapy and more! Remote healthcare has exploded since the start of the pandemic in 2020. The expansion of telehealth and other remote healthcare options is expected to only increase in future years and become a “normal” part of healthcare delivery, enabling specialists and providers to reach patients in remote areas and eliminating barriers to receive safe, efficient healthcare.

POSTBACCALAUREATE CERTIFICATES

SCHOOL NURSE CERTIFICATE

This online, 12-credit certificate program prepares students for PA Department of Education School Nurse (PK-12) certification. You can complete the 100-hour clinical requirement at your place of employment if the hours are noncompensated for your student capacity. This certification is approved by the PA Department of Education. All course content and time offerings are designed to meet the needs of the student, as well as state standards for certification.

The school nurse certification program is a postbaccalaureate certificate program. A Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) or a Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts degree and current Registered Nurse licensure in this state are required for certification of School Nurse Certificate candidates.

POSTMASTER'S CERTIFICATES

FAMILY/INDIVIDUAL ACROSS THE LIFESPAN NURSE PRACTITIONER

This postmaster's certification option is designed to provide individuals who already hold a Master of Science in Nursing degree with the core courses and clinical experience necessary for eligibility for family nurse practitioner certification. Selected courses from a previous MSN program may meet requirements for the postmaster's Family Nurse Practitioner program.

This face-to-face program may incorporate some online components and is approximately 28 credits (upon transcript review). The application dates follow that of the Family/Individual Across the Lifespan Nurse Practitioner MSN based at the campus location.

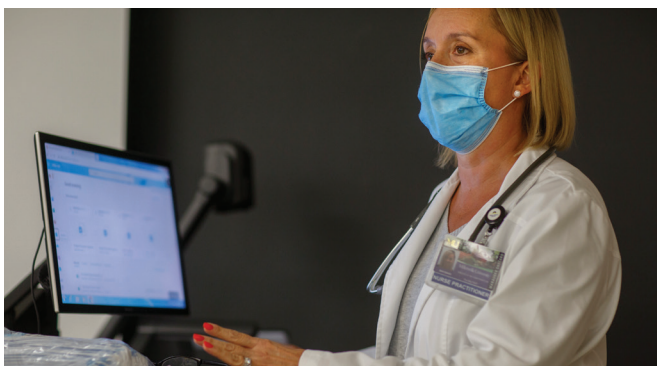
