REQUIREMENTS AND POLICIES FOR THE BSE ART MAJOR

A. Policies for Admission to the Major

1. Art portfolios for admissions consideration must be submitted as 35mm slides, or Macintosh compatible CD's, or photographs. The portfolio should include a variety of the student's best work with at least two drawings from direct observation. 10-15 pieces should be submitted in total. A separate description list should be included indicating the title, medium, date, and dimension of each work. Also, include a S.A.S.E. if you would like your portfolio returned. There will be no in-person reviews. More specific information along with tips on preparing your portfolio can be found at:

2. New students (freshmen and transfers) must be admitted to the Art major by the Office of Admissions upon admission to the University.
3. Admission into the Art major from other departments is upon approval of the chairperson or assistant chairperson of the Art Department.
4. Non-degree and continuing education students must be admitted to the Art major by the Office of Admissions.

B. Policies for Retention in the Major

1. University requirements for retention.
2. All Art majors must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.50 in the Art major courses.

C. Policies for Completion of the Major

1. Completion of all University curricular requirements.

D. Admission to Advanced Professional Studies and Certification (Education Majors)

All students enrolled in teacher preparation programs must be admitted to Advanced Professional Studies and meet Pennsylvania State requirements and university requirements prior to being enrolled in their initial Advanced Professional Studies course. Students must meet additional Pennsylvania State requirements in order to be certified. A listing of Advanced Professional Studies courses and requirements is available in each department office, the Early Field Experience office, and on the Early Field Experience website.
