

Undergraduate Awards

Each year the faculty the Department of Elementary and Early Childhood Education nominates worthy students for the following awards. Award recipients are determined by faculty balloting.

Anne E. Beyer Award. Certificates will be granted to elementary education students at the end of the senior year for outstanding performance in student teaching. The recipients must have spent two full academic years at Millersville in preparation for teaching in the elementary school.

William H. and Alma P. Duncan Scholarship in Elementary Education. The annual interest from the fund established during the 125th Anniversary observance of Millersville University is granted to an elementary education major on the basis of financial need, excellence in scholarship, leadership qualities, and service to others.

Verda M. Fulmer Award. The Philadelphia and Suburban Branch of the Alumni Association presents an award annually to an outstanding senior in elementary education at the end of the school year.

Elsie Hostetter Award. A bond is presented by the Early Childhood Faculty to the outstanding senior majority in early childhood.

Jackson Memorial Scholarship. Established by Dr. George F. and Mrs. Lelia M. Stauffer, this cash award is given annually to a graduate of Hempfield High School who has completed the junior year and has attained distinguished achievement in elementary education. In the event no Hempfield High School graduate is eligible, the award shall be made to the highest ranking elementary education major from a high school in Lancaster County.

Lancaster-Lebanon Reading Association Awards. Presented to an Elementary Education/Reading Area of Interest student who has done outstanding work in the area of reading education.

Helen R. Metzler Undergraduate Reading Award. A cash award to an elementary major who has completed the area of interest in reading and has shown excellence in classroom performance and knowledge of reading techniques.

The Martin and Anna Zimmerman Kondor Award. Established by their children in recognition of Anna Z. Kondor's ('42) thirteen years of service to Millersville University, a cash award will be given annually to a graduating senior in elementary education. Criteria for selection shall include a 3.35 gpa, excellence in the student teaching experience, outstanding personal and professional characteristics, and dedication to teaching.

Helen Koontz Awards. Two awards are made at the end of the junior year to elementary majors who have spent a minimum of two full academic years at Millersville and have devoted two full academic years in preparation for teaching in the elementary schools.

Dana Messman Scholarship. An award established by Joseph E. Strosser presented annually to a senior female Elementary Education major. Criteria include a QPA of 3.5 or above, financial need and evidence of participation in university and professional activities.

Gertrude Bettle Stoll Memorial Award. A cash award to a junior majoring in early childhood education. The major criterion for selection shall be an emphatic concern for the personal, emotional and educational needs of young children. Additionally, the recipient shall possess at least a 3.0 QPA and shall demonstrate financial need.

Ruth Fox Wilkinson Award. An award given by the Philadelphia Alumni Branch to the graduating senior who has attained the highest average in Elementary and Early Childhood Education courses.
