SUBJECT: FACULTY SENATE CURRICULAR RECOMMENDATIONS

I am informing you that the Provost's Office has received on March 21, 2007, and April 4, 2007, the following Actions of the Faculty Senate from its March 20, 2007, and April 3, 2007, meetings. Curricular actions include:

- New undergraduate course: COMM 311 – Environmental Advocacy, 3 credits, G1 designation
- Change in courses/curricula: Add Perspectives designation to existing course; ENGL 483 – Politics, Film, and Electronic Media
- Change in courses/curricula: Add writing-across-the-curriculum designation to existing course; ELED 376 – Assessment for Instructional Planning
- Change in courses/curricula: Revisions to B.A. International Studies program reflecting new course offerings and course number and title changes, require a minor in a foreign language and rename the geographic area specializations
- Change in courses/curricula: Revision to the International Studies minor reflecting new course offerings and course number and title changes
- Undergraduate Academic Policy – Graduation Honors Policy
- Academic Policy – Academic Amnesty
- Change in courses/curricula: PSYC 212 - change prerequisite to completion of PSYC 211 with a grade of C- or higher
- Change in courses/curricula: PSYC 314, 315, 316 - change each course prerequisite to completion of PSYC 212 with a grade of C- or higher
