SUBJECT: FACULTY SENATE CURRICULAR RECOMMENDATIONS

I am informing you that the Provost's Office has received on May 2, 2007, the following Actions of the Faculty Senate from its May 1, 2007, meeting. Curricular actions include:

- New undergraduate course: ENGL 445 – The Short Story: Its History, Development, and Genres, 3 credits, G1 designation
- New graduate course: ENGL 645 – The Short Story: Its History, Development, and Genres, 3 credits
- Change in courses/curricula: Revisions to B.A. Geography, Applied Geography program requiring majors to complete MATH 151 or MATH 160
- Change in courses/curricula: MATH 393 – Number Theory, change the course prerequisite to completion of MATH 310 (instead of MATH 322)
- Academic Proposal: Request to recognize Occupational Safety & Environmental Health as a separate department from the combination of Industrial Technology and Technology Education for the purpose of counting approved general education courses.

These matters will be addressed at the May 16, 2007, Deans' Council meeting.
