SUBJECT: FACULTY SENATE CURRICULAR RECOMMENDATIONS

I am informing you that the Provost's Office has received on April 2, 2008, the following Actions of Faculty Senate, from the April 1, 2008 meeting:

- New undergraduate courses:
 - ANTH 235 – Historical Archeology, 3 credits, G3 designation, pre-requisites: none, elective course for Anthropology major and minor.
 - ENGL 272 - Introduction to Writing Studies, 3 credits, G1 and W designation, pre-requisites: ENGL 110. Will be a required course the newly proposed Writing Studies option and minor.
 - ENGL 340 - Visual Rhetoric, 3 credits, W designation, pre-requisites: ENGL 110. Will be an elective course for the newly proposed Writing Studies option and minor.
 - ENGL 342 - Reading and Writing for Civic Change, 3 credits, W designation, pre-requisites: ENGL 311 or 312 or 313 or 316. Will be an elective course for the newly proposed Writing Studies option and minor.
 - ENGL 466 - Writing Studies Seminar: Special Topics, 3 credits, W designation, pre-requisites: ENGL 311 or 312 or 313 or 316. Will be an elective course for the newly proposed Writing Studies option and minor.
- New GRADUATE courses:
 - SOWK 608 – Social Work Administration and Supervision, 3 credits, pre-requisites: SWK/SOWK 601 or completion of Foundation year. Elective course for the MSW program.
 - WSSD 622 – Sport Finance, 3 credits, pre-requisites: none, distance learning format. Required course for the MED SPRT, Athletic Management program; replacing BUAD 612 – Accounting and Athletic Mgmt course.
- Change in courses/curricula: CSCI 450 - Artificial Intelligence, 4 credits, existing electives course for CSCI majors. Proposal to add the Writing “W” designation to the existing course.
- Change in courses/curricula: BS in Allied Health Technology. Proposal to create a new major program in Allied Health Technology with options in Medical Technology, Nuclear Medicine Technology, Pre-Athletic Training and Respiratory Therapy. The current BS Biology major with options in Medical Technology, Nuclear Medicine Technology, Pre-Athletic Training and Respiratory Therapy will be replaced by this new major program offered by the Biology department.
- Revise Policy: Academic Honesty Policy

These matters will be addressed at the April 16, 2008, Deans' Council meeting.
