SUBJECT: FACULTY SENATE CURRICULAR RECOMMENDATIONS

As the President's designee, I am informing you of the status of the following recommendations regarding Faculty Senate curricular actions from the December 4, 2007, February 19, 2008, and March 5, 2008, meetings. The proposals outstanding are:

- Require placement examination as a pre-requisite for all incoming students for selected courses in French/German/Spanish.
- Revised Pre-requisite: ADD ENGL 110/110H to existing 200-level English courses as a pre-requisite and co-requisite except for ENGL 220 and ENGL 230
- Revised Pre-requisite: ADD ENGL 237 – Introduction to Techniques of Literary Research, to existing 400-level English courses except those with a perspectives “P” or “G1” designation

These academic proposals have been referred to the Dean of Humanities and Social Sciences for further consultation with the departments. These proposals will be reconsidered by Deans' Council in the near future.
