MMAP updates:

MMAP met with Diversity Committee representatives from the Lancaster Bar Association to collaborate on mentor recruitment. They have sent out an informational email to LBA members about our program with information of how to get involved.

The Spring Semester Kick-Off Social was held in the Club de'Ville on January 20th. Approximately 20 people were in attendance.
