

Questions about the Tutoring Center

Q: How much does tutoring cost?

A: Nothing! Just come to the tutoring center and fill out a Tutor Request form. Then, we'll find you a tutor.

Q: How often can I receive tutoring?

A: You can receive one hour of tutoring per week for each credit hour of the class in which you need tutoring.

Q: I need a job. How can I become a tutor?

A: Come visit us at the Tutoring Office and fill out an application. You must have a B+ or better in a course to tutor! Don't forget to ask about our Tutor Training Certification!

Q: If I try Group Tutoring and it doesn't work out for me, may I still get an individual Tutor?

A: Yes. We will do our best to locate an individual tutor for you.

Q: Where is the Tutoring Center?

A: Lyle Hall Room 328, which is located on the third floor directly across from the elevator.

Q: When and where do I meet with my individual tutor?

A: Wherever and whenever is convenient for you and your tutor! After an initial meeting at the Tutoring Center, the tutor and tutee set up meeting times that are mutually convenient. Sessions will take place in a public location on campus.

Q: What about Group Tutoring?

A: Group tutoring is held on a regular basis each week. Please contact the office for more details.

About the MU Tutoring Center

The **MU Tutoring Center** is located on the third floor of Lyle Hall and is responsible for coordinating tutoring services at no cost to all Millersville University students. The Center offers tutoring in courses offered by the Schools of Humanities & Social Sciences, Science & Math, as well as a limited selection from the School of Education. A division of the **Office of Learning Services**, the Tutoring Center also offers workshops on study skills, note-taking, time management, critical thinking, and organizational skills. Additional services are available upon request. Under



the guidance of **Dr. Sherlynn Bessick, Director**, graduate assistants and student workers help coordinate individual and group tutoring services for students.

MU Tutors are students (undergraduate & graduate who have received a B+ or better in the courses they tutor). While a student receives tutoring in a course, their tutor works closely with the professor in order to provide optimal assistance. Tutors have several opportunities each semester to receive **International Tutor Training and Certification** that will improve technique and build more efficient connections with their tutees.

Individual Tutoring

Individual tutoring is a great way for students to get the extra help they need to succeed in course work at Millersville University. Students may request tutoring in courses offered by the School of Humanities & Social Sciences, the School of Science & Math, and the School of Education. Sessions are set up by the tutor and the tutee and typically take place in a convenient public place. The **Tutoring Center** is also available for initial meetings and individual tutoring. Drop-In Group Tutoring

Drop-in group tutoring provides an excellent study environment that allows students to learn from each other with the guidance of a tutor. A typical tutoring session is scheduled at a **recurring weekly time** and is open to all, without an appointment, who wish to receive tutoring.

Unlike individual tutoring, drop-in group tutoring is not limited to a specific course, but has a **variety of different courses** being tutored. Group tutoring is
