Plagiarism is presenting as one's own work:

1. A paper or work wholly or partially done by someone else;
2. A passage copied from another source without giving credit to the author;
3. A creative idea copied without giving credit to the creator.

Academic dishonesty is an act of professional misconduct or dishonesty which includes such actions as plagiarism; presenting false information on credentials, grants, tenure, promotion, etc; and other misrepresentations of one's professional accomplishments and work.

Academic dishonesty and plagiarism are unacceptable within the University community. Those who engage in such conduct are subject to discipline.
