President's Cabinet

The Financial Aid Committee reports to the Associate Vice President for Student Financial Services and has, as its primary responsibility, the establishment and implementation of financial aid policies and procedures.

Membership

1. Associate Vice President for Student Financial Services, as chairperson
2. Associate Director of Financial Aid
3. Chief Diversity Officer
4. Vice President for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management or his/her designee
5. Associate Provost for Academic Support Programs and Dean of Student Success, or his/her designee
6. Vice President for Finance and Administration or his/her designee
7. Two faculty representatives elected by the Faculty Senate to serve overlapping two-year terms
8. Three student representatives elected by the Student Senate for overlapping two- year terms

Functions

1. Review changes to financial aid policies on a regular basis and at a minimum twice per semester.

This includes a review of all new federal and state guidelines as they are presented to the Office of Financial Aid from external agencies.

Modifications

Modifications of the Financial Aid Committee reside with the President or designee.
