University Governance UNDERGRADUATE HONORS and AWARDS COMMITTEE

The Undergraduate Honors and Awards Committee is charged with the responsibility for the determination of recipients of university awards as noted below.

Membership

1. One faculty representative from each of the four academic units (Education, Humanities, Social Sciences, Science & Mathematics) and one representative from non-school faculty recommended by the Deans' Council for overlapping terms of three years. Final appointment resides with the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs or his/her designee. Faculty members may be reappointed to the committee indefinitely with the recommendation of Deans' Council
2. Director, Honors College, or his/her designee.
3. One representative from Student Affairs, appointed by the Vice President for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management.
4. One representative from Financial Aid, appointed by the Vice President for Finance and Administration
5. A representative from University Advancement, appointed by the Vice President for University Advancement.
6. A representative from the Deans Council, appointed by the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.
7. The chairperson is appointed from among the membership by the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs for a one-year term.

Functions

1. Faculty Representatives on the Committee will select award winners for the following University awards: A.G. Breidenstine Scholarship, Schock Foundation Fellowship and the Syed R. Ali-Zaidi Award.
