University President

The Financial Aid Committee reports to the Vice President for Student Affairs and has, as its primary responsibility, the establishment and implementation of financial aid policies and procedures.

Membership

1. Associate Vice President for Student Affairs, as chairperson.
2. Director of Financial Aid.
3. Assistant to the President for Social Equity.
4. Director of Admissions or his/her designee.
5. Assistant Provost for Academic Support Programs and Learning Services, or designee
6. Vice President for Finance and Administration or his/her designee.
7. Two faculty representatives elected by the Faculty Senate to serve overlapping two-year terms.
8. Three student representatives elected by the Student Senate for overlapping two-year terms.

Functions

1. Review all financial aid policies on a regular basis.

This includes a review of all federal and state guidelines as they are presented to the Director of Financial Aid from external agencies.

2. Serve as an appellate body in all financial aid matters, and interpret all financial aid policies concerning student employment to student employees and their supervisors.

3. Review and approve all athletic grant-in-aid awards including those Medal Fund awards that are for athletic grants-in-aid.

Modifications

Modifications of the Financial Aid Committee reside with the President or designee.
