Core Competency Exams

After taking and scoring at least a "B-" in the three core courses, students are required to take and pass all three CCEs

The CCEs must be taken during the semester as the final exam of the course

Students may retake sections that they fail but may not move on to Degree Candidacy courses until they pass all three sections.

Students entering the program with a master's degree in a closely related field are only required to take CCE's for courses that are taken at Millersville.
