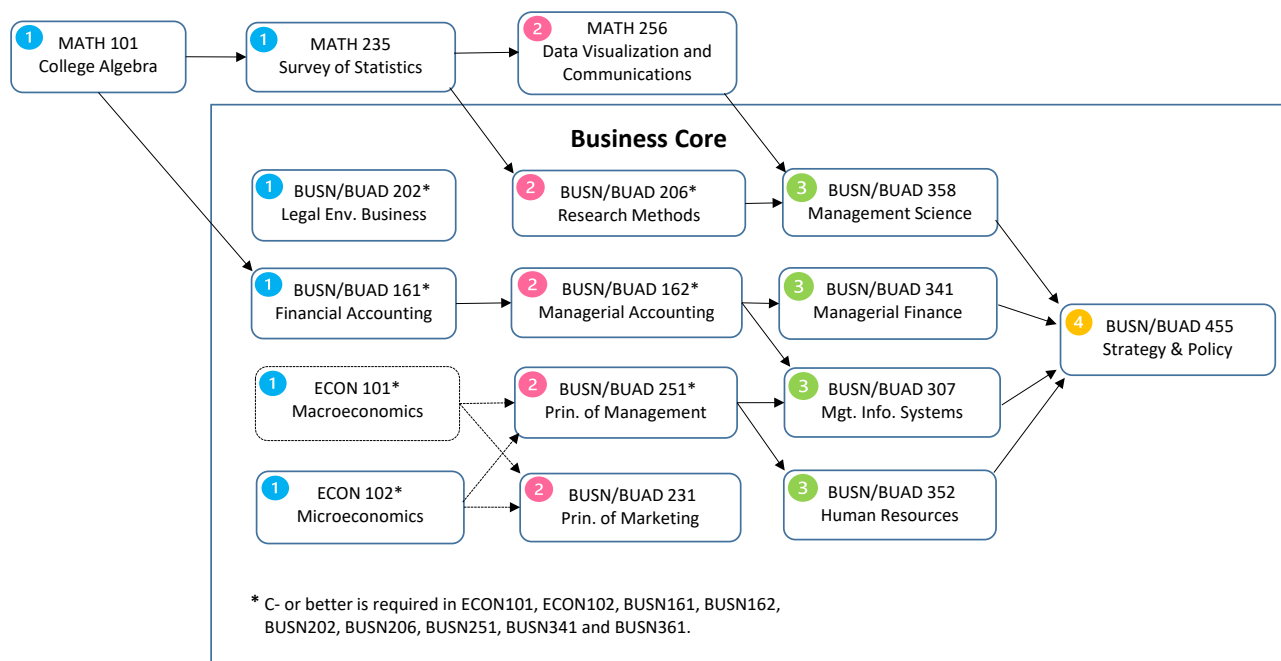


BS Accounting Curriculum Flowchart

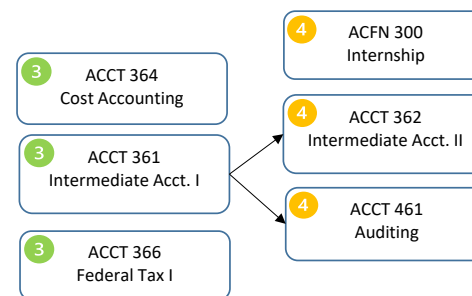
