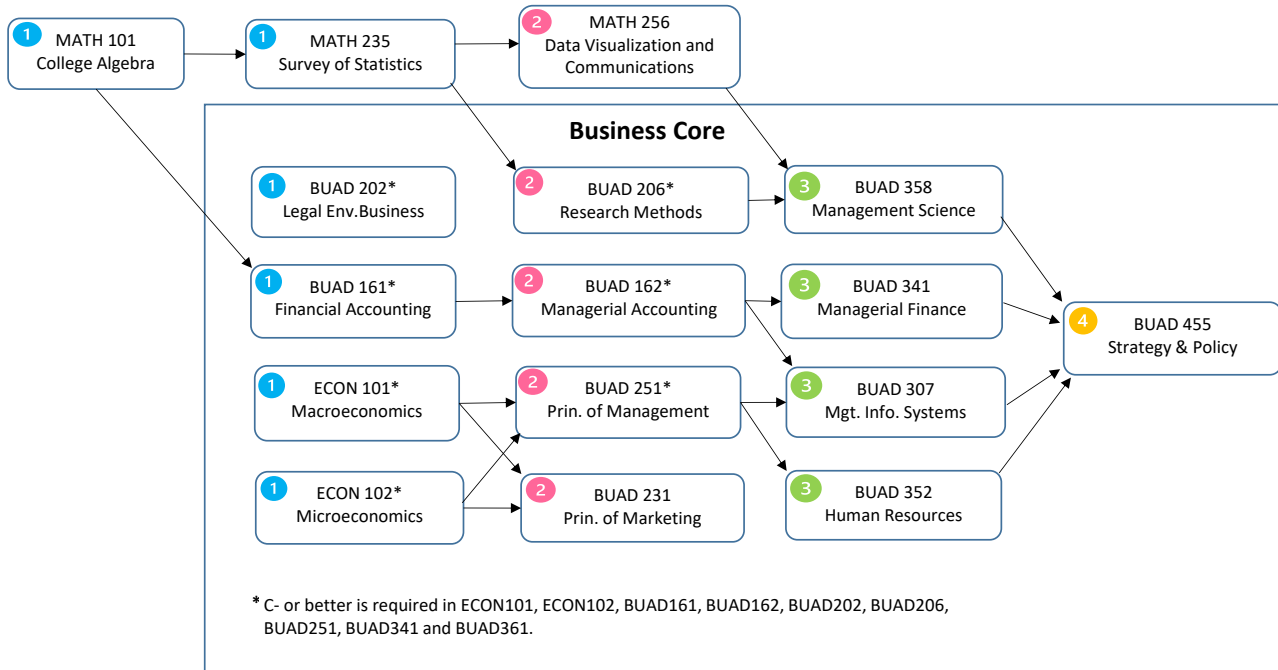


BS Business Administration (International Option) Curriculum Flowchart
