# **FINANCIAL AID**







### Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Complete and file the FAFSA beginning October 1, 2021. The priority deadline for Millersville is March 15, 2022 (Millersville's federal school code is **003325**).
- To apply for aid for the academic year 2022-23, you should use income records for the 2020 tax year. You can submit the FAFSA application using estimated amounts if you have not completed your tax returns.
- For fastest and easiest processing, complete the FAFSA online at fafsa.ed.gov.
- To complete and sign the FAFSA or to make corrections to your FAFSA, you (and a parent, if you are a dependent student) must create an FSA ID and password at **fsaid.ed.gov**.
- To be considered for a Pennsylvania State Grant, you must have completed the FAFSA prior to May 1. To update your state grant award to Millersville, go to **pheaa.org**.
- Make sure to frequently check your myVILLE Student Portal >
  Finances > Financial Aid Requirements to see if there are additional
   documents you need to submit.
- You may later be required to submit copies of your and/or your parents' tax transcripts and W-2 forms to comply with federal verification once you have paid your Confirmation Fee.

# **Federal Work Study**

 If you wish to be considered for Federal Work Study, you must complete a FAFSA before March 15, 2022.

#### **Direct Student Loans and Alternative Loans**

- The FAFSA also serves as your application for a Direct Student Loan; if you have completed a FAFSA and met the eligibility criteria, you will be offered a Direct Student Loan.
- Parents may apply for a Direct Parent PLUS Loan in their name to assist with the student's cost of education. A FAFSA must be on file. Applications can be completed by the parent at studentaid.gov.
- Students/parents may apply for an alternative loan from their choice of private lenders.
