Changes In General Education

Millersville's Core Curriculum Will Require More Writing, Develop Critical Thinking

Next Year's Freshmen Face Tougher Requirements

Millersville has a year to get ready.

Beginning next September, Millersville students—and faculty, as well—will be working in a learning environment that will be more demanding.

Millersville's new general education requirements will go into effect then and will change the way many existing courses have been taught. Many new courses must be added and some old ones must be revised. There is a lot to be done during the next year.

General education is that half of the curriculum everyone takes, usually during the freshman and sophomore years, to acquire a broad liberal arts foundation. Every college requires of all students some form of "general education" or "core" courses. Millersville's general ed requirements, established 20 years ago, allowed a wide latitude in course selection. But, freshmen in 1988 will face a core curriculum that has fewer electives and more courses that emphasize writing, quantitative problem-solving, critical thinking and the interrelationship of ideas.

Millersville's general education component probably is remembered by alumni of the last 20 years as "the front side of the yellow sheet" where they ticked off each course of the mandatory 60 credits.

The curriculum sheets stored the record of completion of five required courses in each of three major areas: science and mathematics, social sciences, and the humanities. In addition, every student took English composition, speech, swimming, health and two other physical education courses, and liberal arts electives to make up the rest of the general education block. The 1987 freshmen are the last MU students to use the old yellow form.

Next year, new students—and any current student who chooses to switch to the new curriculum—will have more strenuous general education requirements. The new curriculum calls for a liberal arts and sciences core of 12 courses, four each in the three major areas. The amount of choice in selecting these courses is limited.

At least four of the 12 courses must include a writing component. Certain courses will be designated with a "W"

to indicate that they fulfill the writing requirements. They're only part of the new emphasis on writing. Students must complete English composition during the freshman or sophomore year and then pass a writing competency test to qualify for a required upper-division writing course. For most students, that course will be advanced composition; a few may fulfill the requirement through an alternative, such as writing an honors thesis. For students who don't pass the competency exam on the first try, help will be available in a writing center. Eventually everyone must pass, because completion of the advanced course is a graduation requirement.

There are other limitations on choice. All students must take at least one quantitative analytical thinking course (usually mathematics) and one science course with a laboratory. Also, four courses in the liberal arts and sciences core must have a communications, mathematics or quantitative analysis component—a requirement designed to improve critical thinking ability.

The swimming requirement has been dropped. Students may take three

credits of any health or physical education courses they wish. The faculty's conviction that students need oral communication skills resulted in retention of the speech course requirement.

Probably the most unusual feature of the new general education curriculum will be a two-course unit called "Perspectives." To be taken during the junior or senior years, the content of these courses will be interdisciplinary or multicultural in nature and will require that students make connections between disciplines.

The new program sounds tougher and, if it comes together as planned, it will be. Under the old program, it was possible for students to take almost all of their general education courses in 100 level introductory courses and, by careful selection, avoid mathematics or courses with papers. That won't happen any more.

Why is Millersville making its general education curriculum tougher? We asked that question of Millersville's new provost, Dr. Alfred Forsyth, who has responsibility for the academic program.

His answer begins with the historical perspective. "In the late '60s and early '70s, colleges and universities responded to student demand for more freedom in general and for more choice in course selection. The result for many

colleges—Millersville included—was the smorgasbord approach.” Often, he said, the “curriculum was based on academic territory—three credits here, six there.”

Forsyth adds that many institutions did not couple the increased freedom in course selection with extra doses of academic advising. As a result, many college graduates over the last two decades were not required to develop good writing skills or to become high level critical thinkers. This occurred at the same time that students nationwide were becoming more oriented to learning by memory than through critical thinking. Gradually, more and more students selected courses that could be passed solely by memorization and objective testing.

A good general education curriculum, Forsyth believes, is based on an identification of what the institution believes are its goals and objectives. “We must ask ourselves what we are trying to achieve, in change, for students, from the time they enter the University until they leave. Should they be able to write better, communicate more effectively, solve problems, think critically? Should they have an understanding of the disciplines that comprise the humanities, the social sciences, the sciences? If we say ‘yes, those are our goals,’ and we say we want them for all of our students, then they become our goals for general education.”

Quick Facts

1. The Liberal Arts and Sciences Core

12 liberal arts and sciences courses: four each in humanities and fine arts, science and mathematics, and the social sciences.

Four must have a writing component.

2. The Communications Component

English Composition

In addressing those questions, Millersville's faculty reached the conclusion that the curriculum as it existed needed to be strengthened. Work began six years ago on designing a new curriculum and a number of individual faculty contributed hundreds of hours to the project.

The work isn't finished. During this semester, each department will examine the courses it offers to determine which ones to submit to meet the liberal arts and sciences requirement and which of those may carry the “W” (writing) or “CT” (critical thinking) designation. Many courses will be redesigned to qualify and every one who teaches the course must agree to the changes. Also, new courses that meet the “Perspectives” requirement must be developed.

Each department must submit its proposals for general education courses to faculty committees for approval. The year ahead could be a struggle for the Faculty Senate as it wrestles with approving departmental and school recommendations. Forsyth says getting everything in place over the next year will be “an administrative nightmare and will take a great deal of work by

the faculty. Making all the changes and providing the staffing will be a major challenge. But that's what's exciting. If it were easy, we probably wouldn't have changed very much.”

Forsyth commends the faculty for the new program. “It is a good indicator of how committed our faculty are to providing students with a high quality education and accepting greater involvement in the learning process.”

Once the new curriculum is in place, many faculty will need to make adjustments in the way they teach. In the last decade, some faculty have succumbed—often reluctantly—to

computer-scored objective examinations that test more than anything else their students' ability to memorize. That teaching mode becomes a vicious circle that Forsyth believes must stop.

It is a circle that begins with high school graduates arriving at college still thinking at the concrete operational level, a term used by psychologist Jean Piaget to describe the cognitive development stage that typifies adolescent thinking. The thinker at the concrete operational level must have a concrete reference for ideas and is unable to manipulate abstract ideas or interrelate ideas across disciplines. Higher education requires thinking at the abstract level (Piaget calls it formal operational thinking).

In the early '60s, approximately 80 percent of the students entering college were at the abstract thinking stage. Research done in the late '70s indicates a shocking flip-flop. Of the entering freshmen, 70 percent were still at the concrete operational mode of thinking. High school students hadn't made the transition from concrete to abstract thinking, despite the fact that SATs and high school grades stayed basically constant.

"We don't know why," Forsyth said. "We know that television watching went up and reading declined, but we don't know all of the societal causes that contributed to the change. It brought a new challenge to college faculty. We had given increased freedom to students at a time when their thinking mode was not appropriate for that kind of freedom. Teaching styles necessarily adjusted to thinking styles.

"The student who is a concrete operational thinker is unable to interre-



late ideas across disciplines. All they can do is memorize what the teacher says. They can't use lots of different information to converge on a right answer, they can't do creative divergent thinking.

"The major complaint of faculty is that students just memorize. Faculty are frustrated, because no matter what they say, students accept it and write it down.

"Faculty who went to college many years ago are most likely to teach their discipline the way they learned it. For most, that was using the abstract or formal operational mode of thinking. Teachers assume that their students

learn the way they learned, and if that is not the case, the result is conflict. The easiest way to handle the conflict is to give in. When students say 'I can't understand,' or 'the course is too hard,' the faculty member shifts to memory questions. We wouldn't get so upset if we understood that these are concrete operational thinkers who are being presented abstract ideas. Their only solution is to memorize. We have to give them the experiences that will allow them to shift from the concrete to the abstract as early in their college experience as possible. We have the challenge that eighth and ninth grade teachers had 30 years ago."

Forsyth points to evidence that indicates that, nationally, more and more faculty are conforming to student thinking styles. A recent study of all exams given at 44 colleges showed that more than 95 percent of examination questions tapped only memory. "Millersville's exams are not anywhere near that 95 percent memorization level," Forsyth says, "and we'll be moving even further away in the future."

The flip side of the problem is that

recent graduates who learned through memorization, and became teachers, may teach that way in their classrooms, producing more college freshmen who are not ready for abstract thinking. The circle must be broken by new teaching approaches, by helping students learn to think critically.

What do we say to all of our graduates since 1970? What kind of education did they receive? Is it possible that they are still concrete operational thinkers?

"From what I know about Millersville's history of excellent academic programs," Forsyth replied, "my guess is that most graduates received a fine education. The problem was not in what was available, but in what was required. Our loopholes made it possible for students who worked at it to avoid taking the kinds of courses that ensured a well-rounded education—to avoid courses that made them think."

Even if some MU graduates left Millersville at the concrete thinking stage, he says, they probably made the change to abstract thinking in graduate school or in career positions that required problem solving skills.

"If you can take a problem, come up with a number of hypotheses, play through the scenario of what would happen if each were followed, use information that is available from discrepant sources, and arrive at some answers, you are at the abstract level," Forsyth explained.

In today's business and professional worlds, broad analytical thinking skills are as important as knowledge in a specific discipline.

During the six years of study and development of the curriculum, one issue that received heavy debate was the possibility of a foreign language requirement. The faculty decided not to require it in the general education block, but students can take a foreign language to fill the humanities requirement. Also, an advanced composition course in a foreign language could satisfy one of the required upper division writing courses.

Changing general education curricu-

lums is happening around the country. Forsyth believes Millersville will go one step beyond most schools. "Not only are we concerned with depth, but the 'perspective' segment in the junior and senior years will provide breadth and force students to deal with the interrelatedness of ideas."

Also being developed are formal academic minors that will become available in most departments, giving future graduates a level of expertise in two fields.

Five years from now, every Millersville graduate will have completed a demanding undergraduate program: met the requirements of at least one major, probably a minor, taken at least four courses with writing components, four courses requiring quantitative critical thinking, an advanced writing course in addition to English composition, oral communication, and two upper-division interdisciplinary courses. They will be prepared for the learning and problem solving demands of the 21st Century.

He Heads Academic Affairs **Al Forsyth: Softness, Strength & Silliness**

Al Forsyth is a gentle man. So gentle, in fact, that his friends worried that he wasn't mean enough to be a good administrator.

But he was a smashing success as dean of arts and sciences at Bloomsburg University and now, as provost and vice-president for academic affairs at Millersville, is gaining respect of faculty, staff and students who are becoming acquainted with his quiet, effective ways. They are finding strength behind a soft voice, a beard and a belief in people.

When Forsyth was announced as Millersville's choice for the second highest position on campus, Bloomsburg's faculty told their friends at Millersville that MU had selected a humanitarian and a real gem of a person.

September 2 was Forsyth's first anniversary at Millersville and his personality—accurately described by his friends at Bloomsburg—proved enormously helpful during a year when MU faculty finally brought to a vote the long-studied proposal for a new general education curriculum.

He arrived at a time in the discussions when many decisions were just at the point of Faculty Senate vote. Some committed faculty believed the new curriculum should have even more requirements and were disappointed at the decisions. The final vote of the whole faculty came in February, with approval reached by a two to one margin.

Forsyth has worked since then to encourage pride and a high measure of satisfaction with the changes among *all* faculty. Harmony is important to him personally and professionally. The huge task of implementing the general education program will go more smoothly if there is wide-based support and acceptance. He probably will get it.

It is difficult not to be influenced by Al Forsyth's style of interpersonal relationships: respectful of others' opinions, complimentary of each individual's contributions and strengths, modest and self-effacing, non-challenging and positive. Usually grinning.

A native of Kearney, New Jersey, Al Forsyth went to college at Dickinson where he was a member of the class of 1961. Both he and his wife, Peggy, earned master's degrees in psychology at North Carolina State University. In 1964, they moved to West Lafayette, Indiana, where Al earned his doctorate from Purdue in 1967. He taught briefly at Purdue, but took his first tenure track position in the department of psychology at the University of New Hampshire. He was at New Hampshire for 11 years. His son Scott, now 16, was born there and the Forsyth family was very comfortable in the beautiful New England setting.

But Al Forsyth has a theory that everyone should reexamine their lives every ten years—should ask themselves what they would do if they were just getting out of school. That exercise took him away from New Hampshire, brought him to Millersville and may someday take him to an eighth grade classroom.

"When I reached the ten-year mark at the University of New Hampshire, I realized I wanted to get back into undergraduate education. I had been responsible for the graduate level statistical research courses in psychology and everyone's expectations were that I would keep doing that indefinitely. That wasn't something I wanted to do for 20 more years, so I began looking at what was available. I looked at research positions, teaching positions in liberal arts colleges and major universities and a few administrative positions.

"Much to the surprise of most of my colleagues, I selected the position of dean of arts and sciences at Bloomsburg. My faculty friends couldn't believe that I would move into administration.

"I don't really blame them. We always picked on administrators. We didn't think administrators could be good, fair-minded people. Until the year before, I thought that dean was a four-letter word."

Forsyth had been at Bloomsburg nine years when he made the decision to accept the provost position at Millersville. Again, the family was content in their attractive Bloomsburg home. His wife, a child psychologist, had been involved in her profession, co-authoring a book entitled "Toward Understanding Children," which she is now revising. Scott was doing well

in school and another child, Chris, was added to the family, adopted at age four months.

But, even though Al's ten years weren't up, he had already been thinking about leaving. "I had planned to go through the same exercise as I had done at New Hampshire, but this position came up before I got started."

Forsyth says he explained his "start over every ten year theory" to President Caputo during his interview and, when Dr. Caputo asked him what he thought he would do next, he said he would really like to teach mathematics in a middle school.

"I thought I had lost the job on the spot. But it is true. That could be what I do next. I love the seventh and eighth grade levels. I believe that's a time when you can really make a difference as a teacher. I think Joe Caputo expected me to say I would be looking for a college presidency.

"I've told my wife that she's to get me psychiatric help if I ever agree to take a presidency."

That's the kind of teasing statement Al Forsyth will make—sometimes in the middle of the most serious discussion. He enjoys being silly, such as answering his secretary's buzz with "Htysrof Derfla" (that's Alfred Forsyth backwards). He is a prankster, but a kind one. Last October 31, he came to work wearing a Halloween costume and, last November, he donned jeans and a tee shirt and performed in a student air band competition. (He didn't win.)

The Forsyths have settled nicely into the Millersville community. They are active at the First Methodist Church where Al teaches the high school Sunday School class. The family purchased a home just a half-mile from Millersville and Scott has been well accepted at Penn Manor where he is involved with music and soccer. Chris is a squirmy smile in motion.

"When we adopted Chris," his father says, "we thought we were doing something that was societally appropriate, but we, rather than he, have gotten all the benefits. He is delightful."

Forsyth says things like "societally appropriate" all the time without pausing to search for the words. His language—both oral and written—is full of five-syllable words that don't match the informality of his warm, personable nature.

But in formal or informal words, Forsyth makes it clear that he has been won over by the beauty of the Lancaster area and the fine people who live and work here.

"Millersville has a large core of caring faculty, as dedicated to teaching as any faculty one is likely to find in this country. They are interested in being teachers, not in building a vita. I enjoy the free exchange of ideas, the positive outlook and the friendliness."

What about the future for Al Forsyth?

"There is nothing worse than administrators who stay too long, lose their effectiveness, but don't know it. Someday Millersville may need different academic leadership. At that time, even if it hasn't been ten years, I'll think again about what I want to do with my life. But, I hope it is not soon. I love the University and the Lancaster area. And I'm having a blast."

Report of Gifts 1986-87

Curriculum changes, reported on the previous pages, will affect the future of Millersville University and its students for decades. There is little question that the newly-adopted strong general education program will make this fine University even better. Private giving also impacts quality with support to a wide variety of academic programs. Contributors are investors in the future of the University and the future of our society. They believe higher education prepares young people today to solve world problems tomorrow. During 1986-87, a record number of donors—more than 6,000— participated in the Giving Program at Millersville, helping to provide the extra edge to many quality University offerings. In all, private support topped three-quarters of a million dollars. Of that amount, \$408,000 was contributed to the Annual Fund to be added to the University's operating budget in support of academic programs, scholarships, equipment, alumni programs and the library. The remainder were contributions of property, gifts to support capital projects, and endowed gifts. Summaries of all giving programs and lists of all donors are provided in this report. Annual Giving

The theme of the University's private giving program "Growing for Tomorrow" accurately reflects the response of donors for 1986-87.

The University is especially pleased with the number of new donors and the number of unrestricted gifts, as well as the increase in the dollar amount given to the Annual Fund. The total of all private gifts to the University for 1986-87 was \$788,873. Some of the highlights of the past giving year were:

- The number of donors jumped by more than 1,400, an increase of 28 percent over last year. Included in that figure were 626 more alumni gifts and 428 more parent donors.
- Ninety-two percent of the gifts from alumni to the Annual Fund were unrestricted. Of gifts from all sources to the Annual Fund, 44 percent were unrestricted.
- Student Scholarships awarded by the SICO Foundation were in excess of \$100,000.
- Endowed giving surpassed the \$100,000 mark, highlighted by gifts from the Classes of 1927 and 1937.
- The Senior Class gift project raised \$3,900.
- The first parent phonathon was held and resulted in the Parents' Fund surpassing its goal by \$10,000.
- Friends of the University contributed an all-time high of \$50,785.
- Business and Industry, with gifts of cash and property, contributed \$162,327.
- The employees' MEDAL Fund continues to grow and provides scholarships for outstanding freshmen.

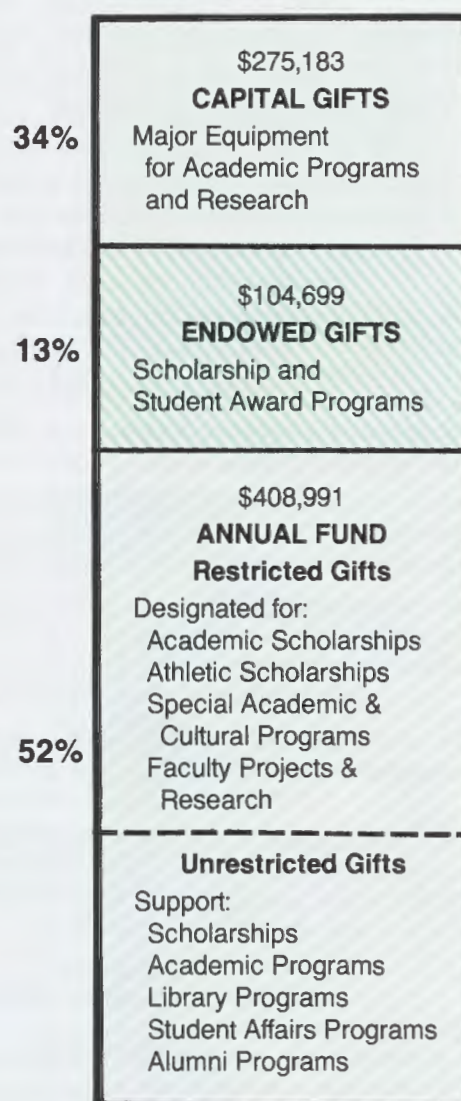

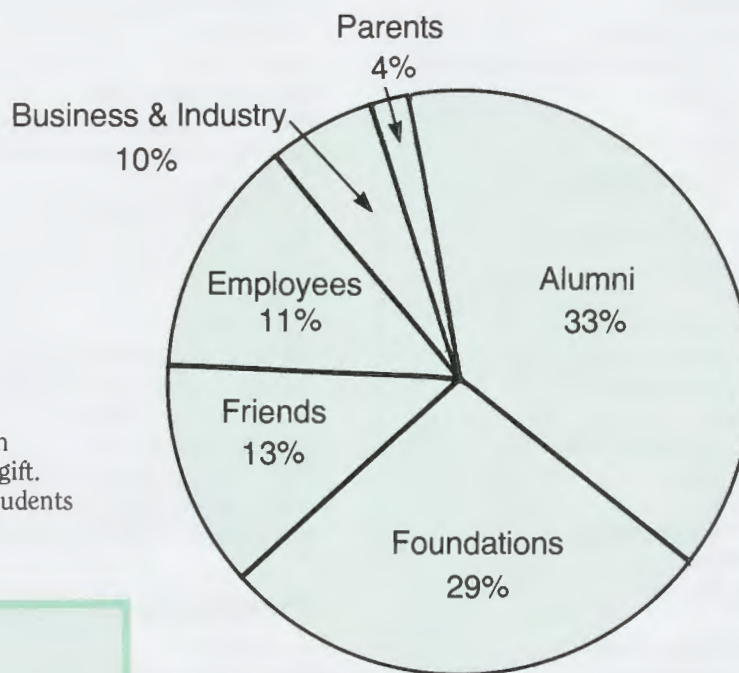

Raised: \$132,714

Alumni donations to the Annual Fund totaled \$132,714 in 1986-87, surpassing last year's total by \$12,000. The percentage of alumni making gifts jumped from 16 to 19 percent of the alumni body, with 4,556 donors.

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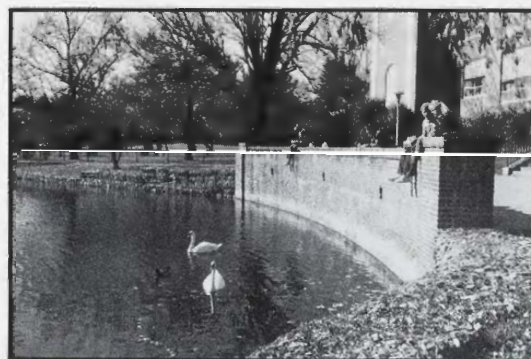
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Alumni Giving by Class

The MEDAL Fund

Goal: \$45,000

Raised: \$46,694

Since 1982, contributions to the University by employees and campus groups have been coordinated by the MEDAL Fund (Millersville Employees Dedicated to the Advancement of Learning). In 1986-87, the fund generated 231 gifts from individuals, three gifts from campus organizations and five corporate matching gifts. Thirty percent of University employees participated. The MEDAL Fund supports excellence at the University through student scholarships, and faculty and staff development grants.

On July 1, 1986, the Fund had a balance of \$99,441. Last year, gifts of \$46,694 were added along with earned interest of approximately \$2,790. Scholarships and faculty and staff grants of \$34,465 were distributed, leaving a closing balance on June 30, 1987 of \$116,140. Because scholarship winners may maintain the awards for four years, a significant portion of the MEDAL Fund is held in an endowment account which now exceeds \$71,000.

Assets Top \$1 Million

Gifts to Millersville University Foundation

The Millersville University Foundation for the fiscal year 1986-87 reported total assets of \$1,074,410 with principal funds of \$1,029,258, income funds of \$69,328 and operational funds of \$8,824.

In 1980 the Foundation's total assets were \$250,000. Since then interest and dividends have grown from \$21,000 to more than \$60,000 per year. Profits from stocks and bonds since 1980 have totaled \$249,000 and \$560,000 more was contributed by alumni and friends. Endowed gifts to the University during 1986-87 alone totaled \$104,699, surpassing the \$100,000 mark for the second consecutive year.

Endowed accounts can be established through the Foundation for a variety of purposes. At present most support scholarships or award programs. The Foundation is an ideal recipient of bequests and gifts that can be used to establish newly endowed programs or expand current accounts.

Examples of outstanding support to Millersville are major endowed gifts from classes. Currently, the classes of 1927, 1935, 1936, 1937, 1938, 1939, 1943 and 1946 have established or are in the process of establishing endowed accounts with the University in recognition of 50th or 60th class reunions.

Year in Review of the Alumni Association *July 1, 1986 - June 30, 1987*

An all-alumni reception held before dinner Friday afternoon of Alumni Weekend attracted many alumni to Biemesderfer Executive Center.



As the number of MU alumni increases each year, the Alumni Association strives to serve a more diverse alumni constituency. Assisting in this commitment is a group of alumni volunteers who reflect this diversity. Growing numbers of alumni are taking more and more active roles, in both social and service capacities, to serve their fellow alumni and support their alma mater as well. Among the major developments of the past year, listed below, are programs to recognize the alumni volunteers who serve their University and provide the sturdy structure which undergirds the Alumni Association.

- Standing committees were established for Communications, Career Planning and Placement, a Student-Alumni Association, and Alumni Admissions to work with University offices in support of programs that affect students and alumni. These new committees will report their activities quarterly to the Alumni Council.
- The number of branch activities grew from 11 last year to more than 20 during the past year. They were attended by more than 1,200 alumni and guests, often including Presi-

dent Caputo or other administrators or faculty who presented updates on University activities.

- Six Career Forums held last year on campus brought back alumni to interact with students and discuss professional opportunities in sciences, pre-law, communications and English, art, foreign languages and helping professions (philosophy, social work, sociology, psychology, special education). The new Alumni Career Planning and Placement Committee, which directs the career forums, is planning six more forums in 1987-1988.
- Alumni Weekend '87, held May 29-31, was expanded to three days of activities, including seminars, receptions, a volunteer recognition event, a memorial service for deceased alumni, and the traditional Alumni Day Luncheon. Class reunions brought 227 alumni and guests to Millersville for the "Back to School" weekend.
- A year-long project of gathering alumni biographic information, as well as career data and volunteer

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interests, will result in a new Alumni Directory to be published in December 1987. Data collected from questionnaires will be entered into the new alumni-development information system and provide increased accuracy of alumni data.

- The 1987 Distinguished Service Awards were received by William H. Bolger '38 and John F.S. Rees '38. Mr. Bolger, a retired educator, has served for many years as chairperson of the MU Council of Trustees. Mr. Rees is a well-known Lancaster County investment counselor and public servant whose many contributions include long-term involvement with the Millersville University Foundation. The Distinguished Service Award to Young Alumni was presented to Steve DiGuiseppe '82, who has served as an Alumni Council officer, chaired several Council committees and was instrumental in organizing a number of new initiatives for younger alumni.
- The 1986-1987 fall and spring phonathons for the Annual Fund raised in excess of \$50,000 in pledges from alumni. A large corps of volunteer alumni callers contributed to the success of both Phonathons.
- Elizabeth Kauffman '52 successfully completed her second term as
