COMMUNITY FEST FAQ's

Where do I check in?

When you arrive to campus you will park in the Student Memorial Center South Parking Lot. From there proceed towards the Student Memorial Center (SMC, pronounced like 'SMACK'). On the map you will see the outline of campus and the Quad is located near the South SMC parking lot. Look for yellow or gray tents with the Center for Student Involvement and Leadership staff for check in.

Check-in will be located in the Quad under the yellow or gray tent. In the event of rain location check in will be located in Marauder Courts.

Please be sure to report to check in before setting up your tables.

Where should I park?

Please park in South SMC Lot (lot directly off the end of the building by Marauder Courts) and West Village. Parking passes will not be required starting at 2:30pm.

Handicapped parking has been designated throughout the campus. These areas are marked with Handicapped signs. Please only park in a handicapped designated space if you have a pass. The unauthorized use of these spaces will result in a fine of \$100 to \$200. The vehicle may also be towed at the owner's expense.

The Galley, located in the Student Memorial Center, offers a wide range of food court selections. Selections include: ever-popular Mixing Bowl, cheese steaks, International Station, and chicken tenders. Try our Wood Stone pizza and pasta stations featuring our own freshly made pizza dough and whole wheat pasta. Stop by for a made-to-order deli sandwich or enjoy one of our hot soup selections. Starbucks, located in the McNairy Library, a short walk from the Quad, offers many of your favorite Starbucks options including their fair trade coffee, lattes, mochas, cappuccino, espresso, flavored coffees, specialty cold drinks, and upscale pastries. Starbucks is open from 7:30 am – 9:00 pm.
