Formulas

If you eat all your meals in the Dining Hall

15 Weeks/Semester

$$(75 \times \$5.25) + (75 \times \$7.25) + (25 \times \$7.25) + (103 \times \$9.50) \\ = \$2097.25$$

Breakfast - 75/ Semester

Lunch - 75/ Semester

Brunch - 25/ Semester

Dinner - 103/ Semester

Total Meals – 278/ Semester

Retail Locations

Dollar for Dollar Spending

Balance for Use at Retail Locations

Declining Balance Level - Estimated Cost of Meals =
\$_____/ 15 Weeks = Estimate/Week at Retail Locations

\$2,100 divide by 15 weeks = 140

Divide 140 by 7 days a week = 20

Divide 20 by 3 meals a day = \$6.66 for each meal

\$1,950 = \$6.19 each meal

\$1,700 = \$5.39 each meal

\$1,450 = \$4.60 each meal

\$1,000 = \$3.17 each meal
