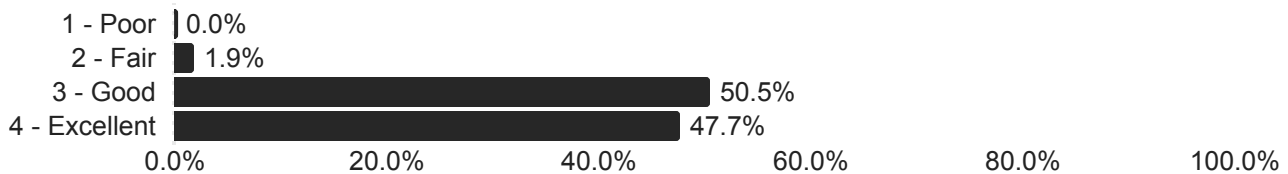

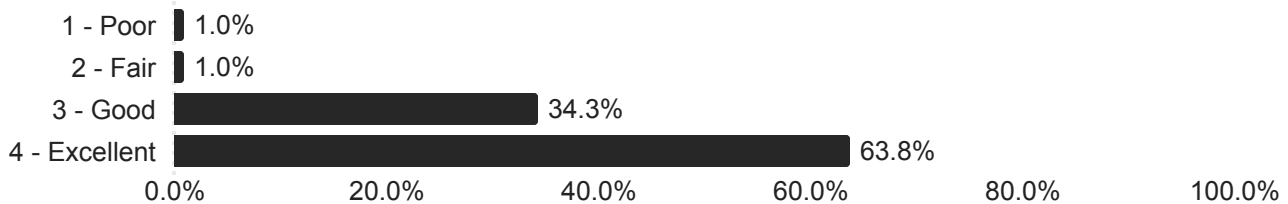

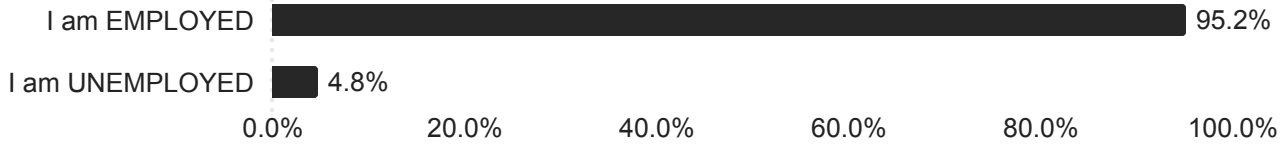

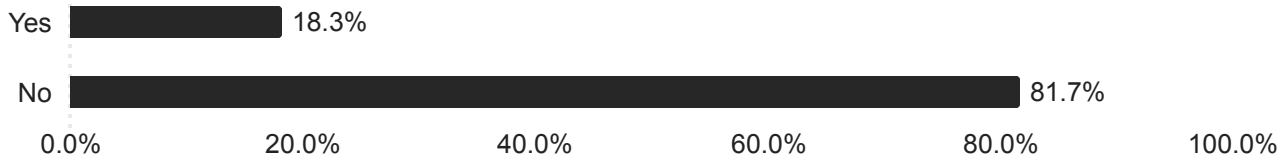

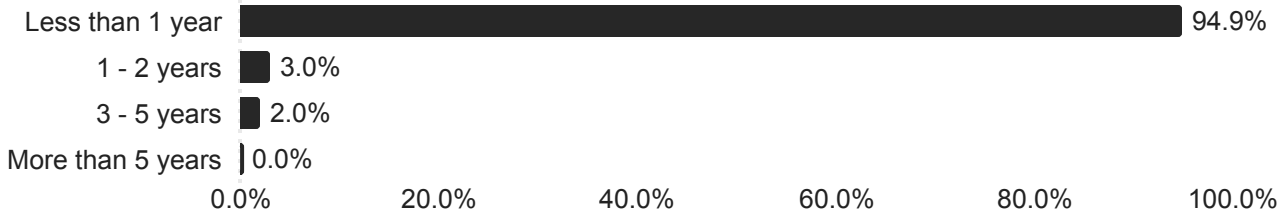

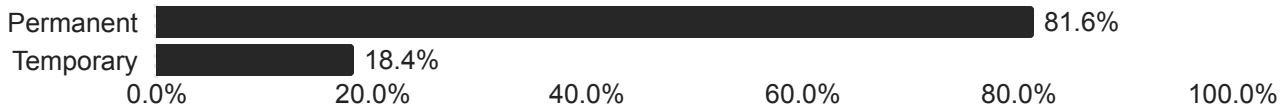

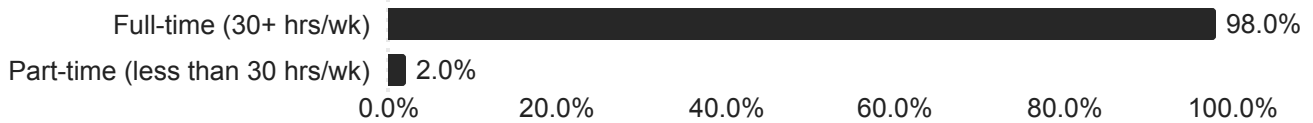

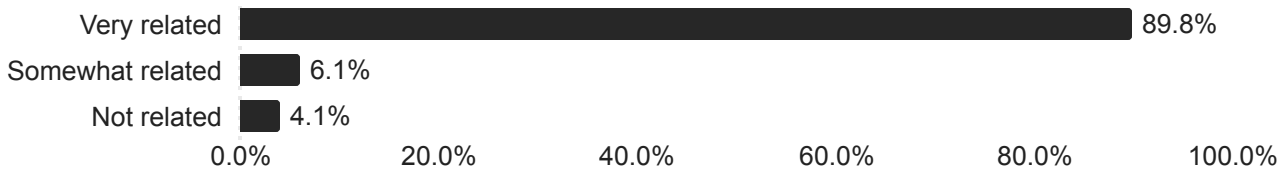
Q8 - Which best describes your current work situation?

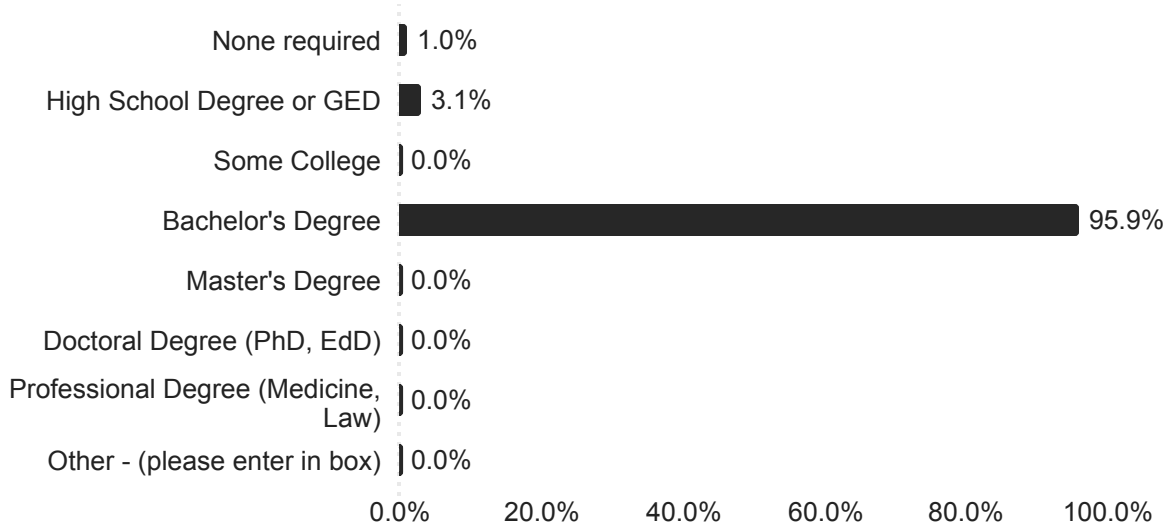
Q9 - Is your current position related to your Millersville University studies?

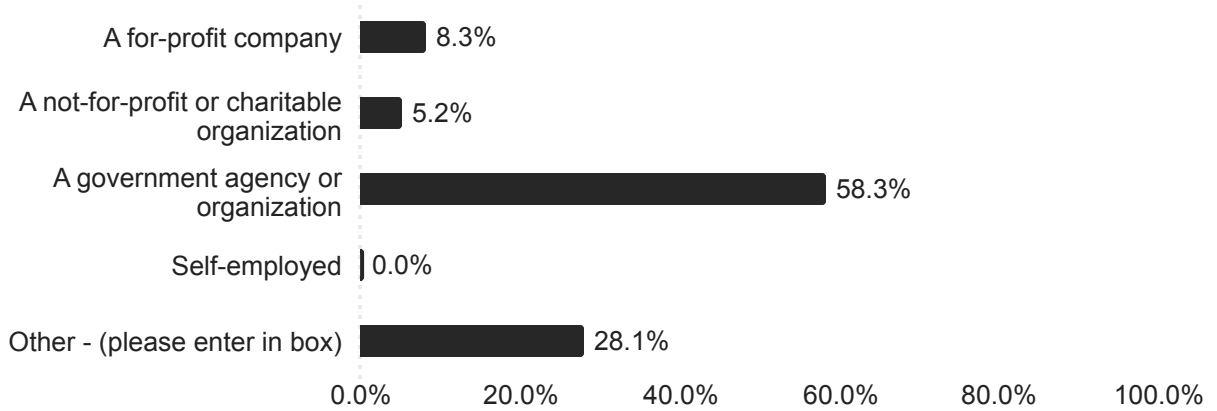
Q10 - What is the minimum level of education required for your job?

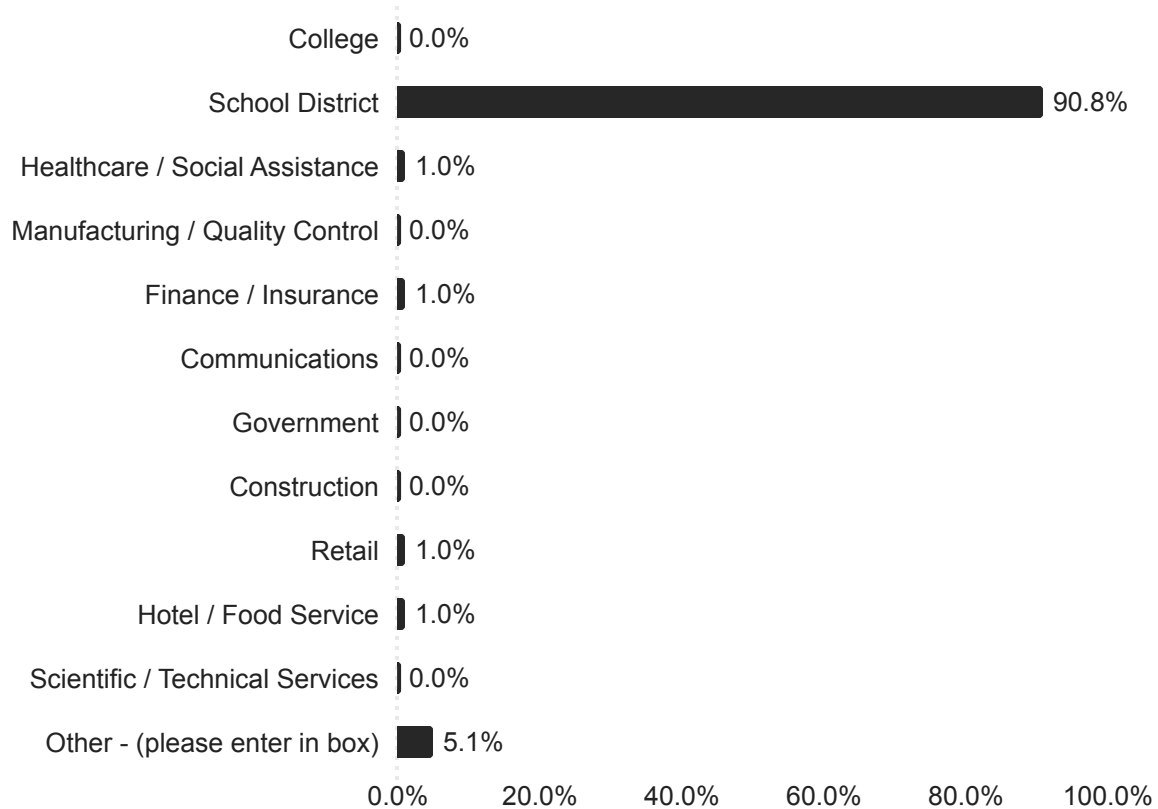
Q11 - Select the type of firm or organization with which you are employed.

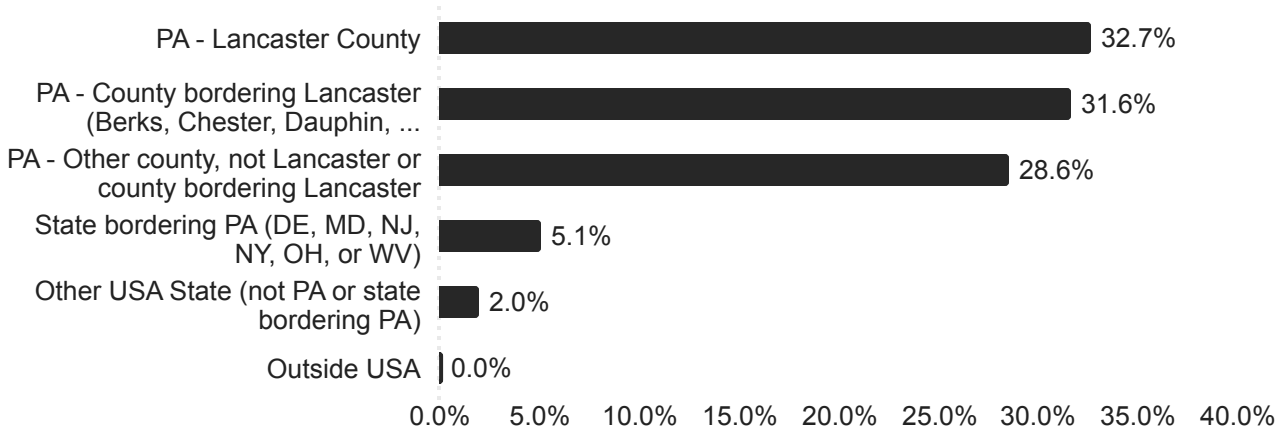

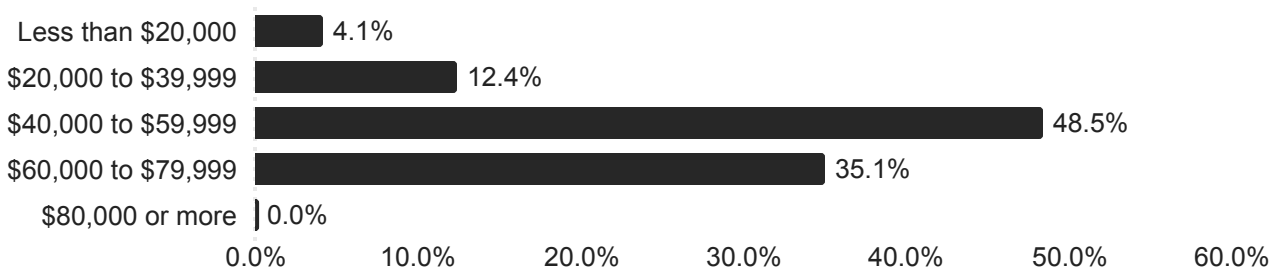

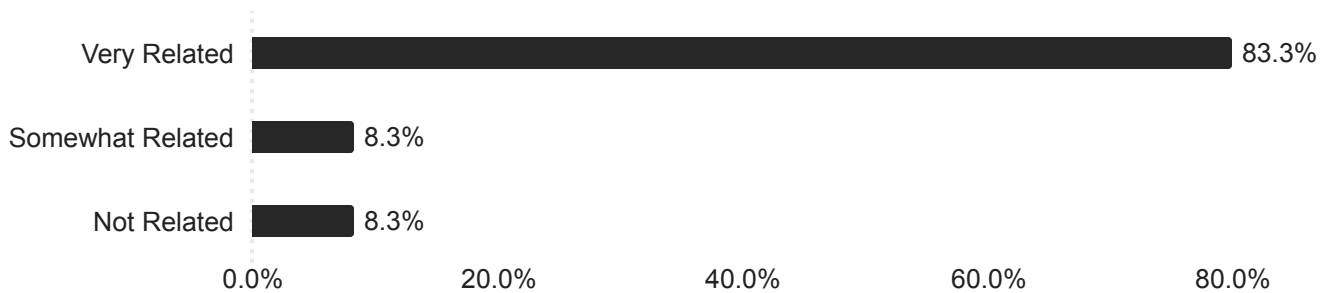

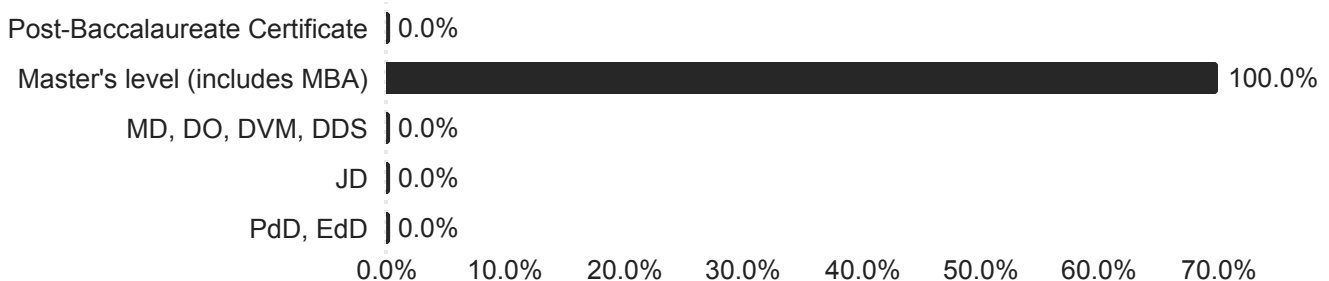
Q18 - Is your program related to your Millersville University major?

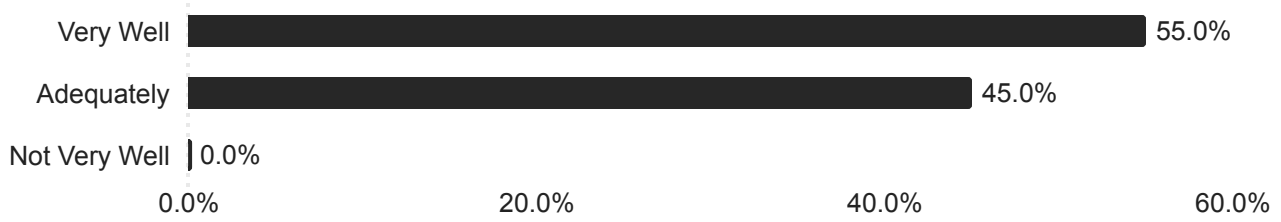

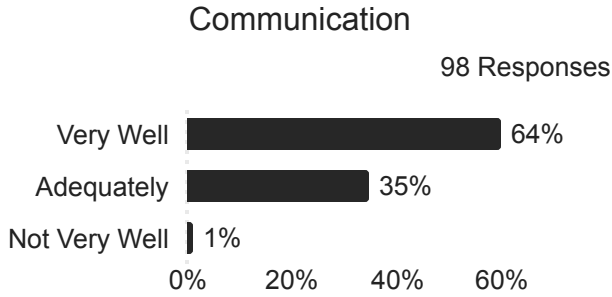

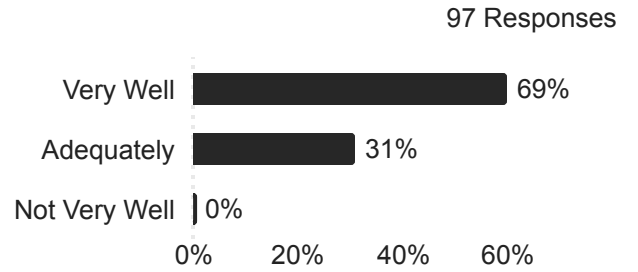

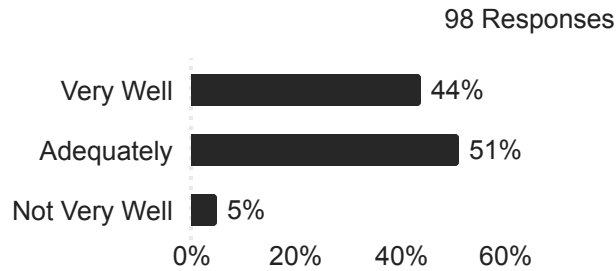

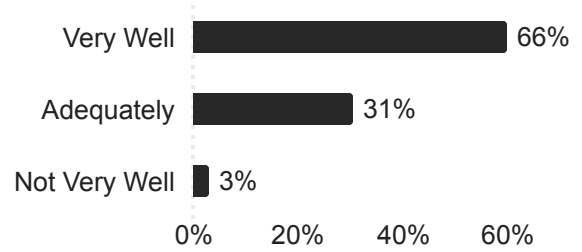

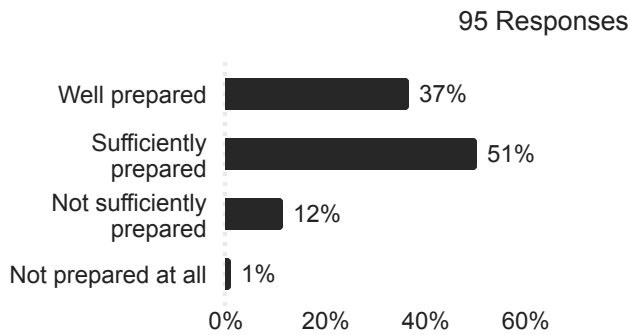
Q27 - How well did these Millersville University experiences help you attain knowledge skills and lifelong behaviors?



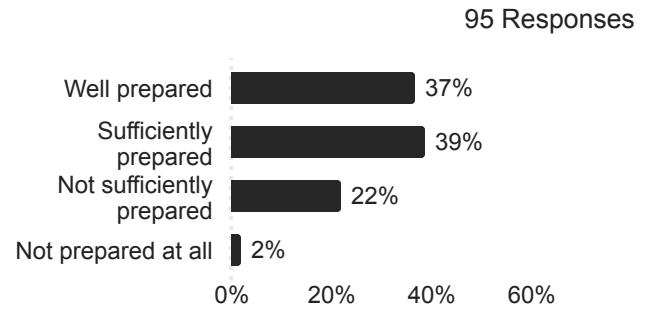

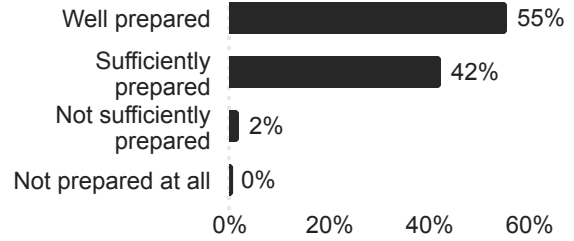

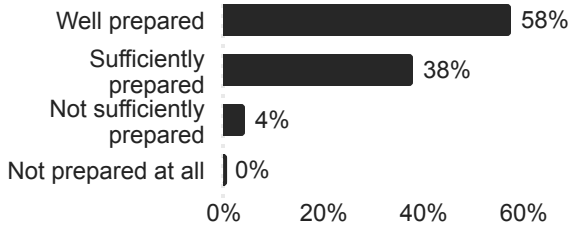

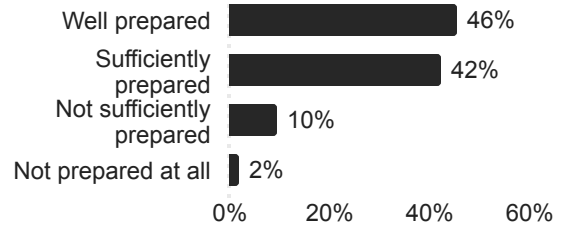
