- Study Abroad in the junior year is highly recommended. Students should discuss their plans with advisors as early as possible. Up to half of the courses in the major as well as general education courses in G1 and G3 may be taken abroad.
- Students are encouraged to use their open electives in combination with General Education courses for a minor in another field.
