- Courses in French, German, and Spanish are not offered during the winter and summer session except for graduate courses in German and Spanish which advanced students may be permitted to take.
- Study Abroad in the junior year is highly recommended. Students should discuss their plans with advisors as early as possible. Up to half of the courses in the major as well as general education courses in G1 and G3 may be taken abroad.
- Study Abroad can be used to waive the Perspectives requirement, otherwise a Perspectives course must be taken at MU.
