

2025-2026 ACTUAL Cost of Attendance (COA)

The Cost of Attendance (COA), also known as the Student Budget, is comprised of both direct costs (*those billed directly by the university*) and indirect costs (*possible costs incurred by a student while attending school, but not billed by the university*). This number is used by the school to determine the maximum amount of financial aid a student can receive for that award year.

Costs listed below are based on full-time enrollment (6 credits) for graduate and post-baccalaureate certification programs. Actual *Tuition/Fee* charges are based on a student's per credit enrollment. For students living on-campus in a Residence Hall, please note that the *Housing* charges listed below are based on a standard double-suite. Actual *Housing* charges will vary depending on a student's room assignment.

- ✦ **The estimated amount it costs to attend Millersville is not the *Total Cost of Attendance*, rather it is the *Total Billable Charges* listed under your anticipated housing plans.**
To estimate the amount that you will owe for the academic year, subtract your total financial aid awards (see your Financial Aid Offer) from your Total Billable Charges (see above).
 - If this calculation results in zero or in a negative number, you have enough financial aid to cover your charges for the academic year.

 - To determine the amount due per semester, divide the yearly amount due by two.
