2019-2020 ESTIMATED Cost of Attendance (COA)

The Cost of Attendance (COA), also known as the Student Budget, is comprised of both direct costs (those billed directly by the university) and indirect costs (possible costs incurred by a student while attending school, but not billed by the university). This number is used by the school to determine the maximum amount of financial aid a student can receive for that award year.

Costs listed below are based on full-time enrollment (9 credits) for graduate and teacher certification students.
