

2023-2024 **ACTUAL** Cost of Attendance (COA)

The Cost of Attendance (COA), also known as the Student Budget, is comprised of both direct costs (*those billed directly by the university*) and indirect costs (*possible costs incurred by a student while enrolled, but not billed by the university*). This number is used by the school to determine the maximum amount of financial aid a student can receive for that academic year and does not reflect actual charges billed.

The COA listed below is based on full-time enrollment of 15 credits. Actual *Tuition/Fee* charges are based on a student's per credit enrollment. For students living on-campus in a Residence Hall, please note that the *Housing* charges listed below are based on a standard double-suite. Actual *Housing* charges will vary depending on a student's room assignment.
