

2024-2025 **ESTIMATED** Cost of Attendance (COA)

The Cost of Attendance (COA), also known as the Student Budget, is comprised of both direct costs (*those billed directly by the university*) and indirect costs (*possible costs incurred by a student while attending school, but not billed by the university*). This number is used by the school to determine the maximum amount of financial aid a student can receive for that award year.

Costs listed below are based on full-time enrollment for doctoral students (9 credits). For students living on campus, please note that actual room charges will vary depending on the student's room assignment.

*** Amounts listed for *Possible Other Educational Expenses* are based on average expenses incurred by Millersville students and are not charged directly by the University. Amounts listed in this category are included in the student's *Total Cost of Attendance/Student Budget* for financial aid processing only.

† The estimated amount it costs to attend Millersville is **not the Total Cost of Attendance**, rather it is the *Total Billable Charges* listed under your anticipated housing plans. To estimate the amount that you will owe for the academic year, subtract your total financial aid awards (see your Financial Aid Offer) from your Total Billable Charges (see above).
