 - (1) CHANGE IN UNDERGRADUATE CURRICULUM
BUAD: change of requirements of intra-university transfer into the BUAD major: minimum of 2.25 grade point average and 30 completed credits.
 - (2) CHANGE IN UNDERGRADUATE COURSE
EDFN 211: change addresses elements of diversity for the D label and to meet the PDE mandated certification changes in Chapter 49-2 to begin in Fall 2009. The revised proposal addresses six of the socio-cultural objectives for meeting the needs of English Language Learners as required by PDE.
 - (3) CHANGE IN UNDERGRADUATE CURRICULUM
BSE PK-12 & Secondary: the addition of three new courses: EDUC 3XX, SPED 3XX, and EDUC 4XX. Revisions of existing Foundations Block and Professional Courses.
